On 31st October 2015 the last three remaining Christian Endeavour Holiday Centres closed their doors, seemingly for the last time. The death-knell of an era of provision of Christian holidays through these facilities for so many years seemed over...or was it?

Although these Centres – The Pleasaunce in Overstrand, St Rhadagunds on the Isle of Wight and Beechwood Court in Conwy – were all closed, St Rhadagunds was the only centre that was actually sold. With the arrival of a new Board of Trustees, CEHC has decided to resurrect its core vision and to reopen Beechwood Court from Easter 2017, with the future of The Pleasaunce still under review.
